

## **Photo of the Day: Oenophiles Celebrate Patron Saint of Wine**

Oenophiles from across France gathered in this tiny Burgundian village to celebrate a medieval tradition in honor of Saint Vincent, the patron saint of winemakers. Following the vineyard procession and a mass, local winemakers open their cellar doors for tastings of their chardonnays and pinot noirs.
